Trained and certified worker in the spa industry that performs spa treatments or spa services for clients.

SPA MANAGER

A qualified and experienced individual in spa services industry with management skills. Trained and certified worker in the spa industry whose primary role is on the day to day management of the spa business.

SPA TRAINER

The trainer of spa workers whose primary role is to perform massage or other technical spa services. The trainer shall be qualified or certified to train such techniques or services. The trainer may also conduct training for other general service or business-related skills whose standard shall be established by the top management.

SPA SERVICE

Services as provided for a client in a spa for the promotion of wellbeing; massage, water applications, steam, sauna, exercise, nutritional treatment and dietary programmes, yoga, meditation, herbal treatment or other professional services aimed at renewing the body, mind & spirit.

- Today's spas different fitness program and beauty care treatments also play an increasingly significant role. Thermal water treatments are not among the compulsory spa services in America or Asia.




• The American-type spa is increasingly becoming a health-centered institution because service providers pay special attention to healthy eating, exercising, beauty and body treatments and meditation.

Spa services in the comfort of home, hotel room, and even in the office with licensed talented professionals.










The National Wellness Institute notes that applying a wellness approach can be useful in nearly every human endeavour as a pathway to optimal living.
